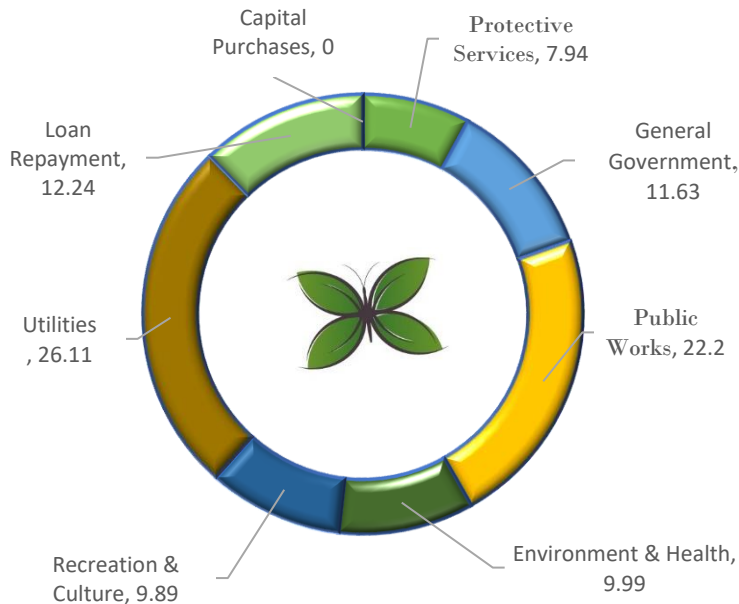

What's New in 2022!

2022 has been, and will continue to be, a year of change in our Garden of Saskatchewan. The most prominent improvement is taking place at the Broda Sportsplex, with significant funding being provided through the Investing in Canadian Infrastructure Program. This facility is being completely updated to maintain access to high quality winter activities, including ice skating and curling, for years to come. We also have a new Recreation & Community Development Manager, Stephen Dutcheshen, who grew up in Kamsack and has already been actively pursuing new opportunities for our community. The Town of Kamsack also entered into a new partnership with Wolkowski Funeral Services to create the Tree Memorial Program, a truly Saskatchewan way to honour and remember our loved ones. Finally, the landfill decommissioning work remains ongoing as the Province has mandated that all non-engineered landfills must be out of operation by 2027 and replaced with a transfer station. To accommodate this coming change and to provide residents with increased opportunities to dispose of unwanted items, municipal leadership has expanded the hours of the landfill as it is now open for eight hours on three separate days of the week.
